- 4.The teacher should thoroughly know the basics of pedagogical and psychological sciences, organize activities in the educational process, taking into account the age and psychological characteristics of students.
- 5.It is important that the teacher is able to make the most effective use of forms, methods and tools in the educational process.
- 6.The teacher is obliged to have creative, initiative and organizational skills.
- 7.The teacher must achieve deep mastery of the rules of pedagogical skill, chunanchi,

communicativeness, pedagogical technique (speech, facial, limb and torso movements, facial expressions, pantomimics, gestures) at a higher level.

- 8.It is necessary that the teacher has a culture of speech, his speech should be able to embody the following features:
 - (a) correctness of speech;
 - b) accuracy of speech;
 - d) expressiveness of speech
 - e) purity of speech
 - f) fluency of speech;
- g) the wealth of speech (ability to make appropriate and effective use of Proverbs, sayings and proverbs, matals and excerpts).
- 9. The culture of teacher dress should not use various decorations that quickly attract the attention of the student in the educational process, achieve the assimilation of clothing in accordance with the season, age, posture structure, face image, even, hair color and style.
