3. "Problematic situation solution" (Creative Problem Solving). To apply this method, the beginning part of the story is read and the readers who find the section of its yakovchi are referenced. This method contributes to the development of thinking skills in the student.

4. "Quick question" (Quick answers) Bunda students will be asked a question on the topic mentioned. This method serves to increase the effectiveness of the mentioned lesson.

5. "Pantomime" (Pantomime)- an explanation of different words by gestures. This method is suitable for the purpose if it is used in a lesson where very difficult topics need to be explained, or when students are tired of doing written exercises. 6. "Story chain" (a chain story)- something is told in a story. This method develops oral speech of readers.

7. The method of "speaking pictures" (When pictures speak) is much more convenient, it helps in teaching English, in developing the oral speech of students, for this it is necessary to use pictures related to the subject.

8. "Quiz cards" (Quiz cards)- this card is distributed according to the number of students and ensures that all students participate in the lesson at the same time, which significantly saves time.

9. "Cluster" method. Allocation to clusters is a pedagogical strategy that helps students to think freely and openly about a particular topic. This method is basically an effective way to evoke new thoughts, add more new ideas to existing knowledge.

10. "Insert" method. Bunda presents a text or story to the reader and requires the reader to re-speak it. This method is considered a powerful method to support activity, observability and understanding when dealing with text. So it turns out that each method, as already mentioned above, has effective ways of



teaching foreign languages. Effective use of modern pedagogical technologies and techniques in each lesson in the teaching process helps students to think independently and freely, to search, to approach each issue seriously, to be interested in acquiring knowledge. If it is able to organize a cooperation activity between the teacher and the reader, both sides will be able to achieve a positive result.
