- This born child is the ruler of this world and the hereafter. Allah Almighty sent him as a blessing to all the worlds. The most beloved servant of Allah and the greatest Messenger is your son. We wish you happiness and blessings, Amina, the happiest of all mothers! - they used to say[21].

At dawn, while the child was lying in Amina's bosom, the countless angels who had come to welcome the ruler of the worlds returned with joy to the world of kingdoms.

Abdulmutalib Rasuli Akram's grandfather came in the morning and opened the baby's face and saw his incredibly beautiful grandson. As he held her in his arms and smelled her cheeks, he clearly believed that it was a heavenly fragrance. The tears that dripped from his eyes were tears of joy.

No eye has ever seen a more beautiful baby. No mother ever gave birth to a more beautiful child. I swear, no one's granddaughter is more beautiful than mine! he said.

The great Turkish writer **Ahmad Lutfiy Kazanchi** wrote in his work "Saadat asr kissalari" dedicated to the life and work of Muhammad, may God bless him and grant him peace: "There is the only and most blissful way to approach God, and this is the way shown by our Prophet Muhammad (pbuh)[24]. Our Prophet personally lived as an example of what moral qualities humanity should live by. Whoever looks for a way other than this will be miserable. Whoever insults him will be disgraced by this world and the next world. Whoever opposes him will be punished."

The truth is that the world has never seen a person as perfect as the Messenger of Allah, may God bless him and grant him peace, a person with beautiful morals who can be an example for everyone, who embodies all the good qualities in the world, and will not see him again. These unique qualities can be seen from the assessment given to Rasuli Akram by Islamic scholars of the East and West[16].

The great German philosopher **Johann Wolfgang Goethe** wrote: "After reading the history of the world, I came to the following conclusion: all the kingdoms, wealth, palaces and palaces accumulated by the kings of the world are not worth even the patched jackets of Muhammad, peace be upon him... We European nations, despite our high cultural potential, Muhammad peace be upon him we

Goethe alluded to the fact that all the kingdoms, wealth and palaces accumulated by the kings of the world are not worth the clothes of our Prophet, but the clothes of a patchwork. Seeing Rasuli Akram on the first rung of the highest step of the stairs, despite the fact that the culture of the nations living in Europe is the highest, is recognition of our Prophet and unlimited faith. And showing that Rasuli Akram was unique from the wound to the end, he expressed with devotion and confidence that all the good qualities that a person possesses are embodied in that person and no one can surpass him[25].

Bernard Shaw says: "If a man like Muhammad were to rule the world now, he would be able to solve the world's problems, which in turn would bring the peace and happiness that the world lacks today."

Bernard Shaw praised Rasuli Akram's greatness, unique and supernatural qualities and confidently said that if there was a person like Rasuli Akram, he would have calmed down the current turbulent world and would have ruled the whole world and ensured peace and tranquility on earth[15].

Lamarty, one of the famous French scientists, has the following words: "If the greatness of a person is measured by his deeds, his victories, the fact that he did a lot despite his limited opportunities, then Muhammad is the greatest of people. He was a prophet, an orator, a politician, a general, a protector of souls, a propagator of ideas, an imam, a statesman, who was able to build an Islamic kingdom in more than 20 regions of the world...Muhammad, peace be upon him, was such a person! If only he could fit in the measurements."

Oxford University professor **William Montgomery said**: "Muhammad's victories and achievements are proof of his greatness. No other person in the West has achieved such a feat. He writes that those who accuse the great being of sorcery are the lamentation of a person who has failed to achieve his goal[26].

The great Russian writer **Lev Nikolayevich Tolstoy** writes in his treatise "Hazrat Muhammad" that there is no problem or mystery in the wisdom of Muslims that "There is no god but Allah, Muhammad is His prophet."

Of course, these are not the only people who became very famous in the West and later converted to Islam. If we look back further, we can see that Franz Bismarck, Goethe, Russian poet Alexander

Pushkin and others also looked at Islam with respect[14].

In 2001, he converted to Islam and became a Muslim, the Chairman of Religious Affairs of Russia V. Polosin. It is noteworthy that V.Polosin declared that he became a Muslim in the presence of mass media representatives of all Russia, among other things, he said: "I testify in front of the whole public that I am neither the pope nor the head of the Orthodox Church. I am now a Muslim. I also testify that I have confessed to the only true religion as a seeker of the true faith, which is the great tradition of all the religions that have a book, starting with Hazrat Ibrahim and all the prophets...".

Western scholars have come to such conclusions because they have studied the history, sirat, and ways of life of the Prophet, may God bless him and grant him peace.

It is known to everyone that after "Holy Qur'an" in the teachings of Islam, the main source is hadiths. The words "Hadith" or "Sunnah" mean the same thing and consist of narrations about the life and activities of the Prophet, as well as his instructions, words, admonitions, and exemplary deeds about religious, educational, and moral education[27]. That is, the exemplary deeds of our Prophet, may God's prayers and peace be upon him, which are a lesson for all mankind, his actions promoting faith, belief, patience, contentment, shame-shame, prayer, purity, religious and spiritual-enlightenment moral guidance, his way of walking, speaking, clothing, eating, drinking water, dealings with people and neighbors, even lying down, and words expressing all the spiritual and moral qualities characteristic of a person, embodied in hadiths, and for nearly one and a half thousand years, humanity on earth has guided its life path to the right path from this priceless treasure. is used to put and live[13].

Dar Haqiqat hadith science is the golden treasure of the Muslim people, especially the Uzbek people. Because the greatest scholars were born and raised in our land. In order to use this golden treasure for the spiritual and moral education of the young generation and to raise them as well-rounded people, by the Decision of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated February 14, 2017 No. In accordance with Resolution No. 483, the activity of the "Imam Bukhari International Research Center under the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan" was established. The main purpose of the establishment of these international centers is to contribute to the development of the holy religion of Islam, the Sultan of Hadith, the Imam of the world, our compatriot



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Imam Bukhari, the great muhaddith Abu Isa Muhammad al-Tirmizi, the Judge of Saints - Hazrat Muhammad ibn Ali al-Hakim at-Tirmizi and other muhaddith scholars. to study its great heritage on a scientific basis, to promote it to our people and the world community, to enrich the spiritual and spiritual world of the young generation based on the preservation and glorification of our ancient national values, to strengthen their faith, and to further strengthen the feelings of love and loyalty to the Motherland in their hearts.

Hadiths were not originally written down. Because at the time when the Holy Qur'an was revealed, our Prophet was afraid that non-Arab peoples (meaning Persians and Turkic peoples) would interpret the hadiths as verses of the Our'an, and on the other hand, there were forces against our Prophet and the holy religion of Islam at that time, and in the name of our Prophet, there were forces against the Holy Qur'an. They did not allow them to write it down in order not to mislead people by narrating false hadiths. But in the presence of our Prophet Muhammad, may God bless him and grant him peace, there were companions who had knowledge and a strong memory, and they memorized the hadiths they heard from the Holy Prophet. For example, Hazrat Abu Hurairah (r.a) was one of such respected people who devoted his whole life to memorizing hadiths.

However, as the number of people who memorized the hadiths decreased and gradually they were prevented from being forgotten, the caliphs ordered the collection of reliable hadiths. Islamic scholars claim that the first caliph, Umar bin Abdulaziz, was the one who initiated this work.

Muhaddith who were engaged in writing the hadith for the first time are mentioned as Rabee bin Sabeh, Said bin Abi Aruba, Malik bin Anas, Abdumalik bin Jurayj Makki and others[12].

In the hadiths, the positive qualities of a person are kindness, generosity, faith, faith, generosity, kindness, compassion, repentance, mutual help, loyalty, humility, affection, love, loyalty, loyalty, hard work, humanitarianism, love of country, loyalty to parents. , patience, purity, truthfulness, friendship, modesty, prayer, chastity, satr, justice, knowledge, mercy, etc. glorified, lying, conspiracy, cunning, deceit, debauchery, anger, aggression, depravity, ignorance , tyranny, treason, impurity, corruption, backbiting, backbiting, immorality, immorality, impurity, bribery, drunkenness, and inhumane vices are strongly condemned.

However, the number of people who memorized the hadiths decreased and the caliphs

The 8th-9th centuries are considered to be the "golden" age" for the science of hadith. By this time, Islamic scholars began to investigate the accuracy of hadiths and what sources they relied on. Because some fake and unreliable hadiths began to appear, they should be checked and restored to the original hadiths. and written records were the need of the hour. From this period, i.e. from 90 A.H. to 708 A.H., the practice of hadith science in Central Asia developed widely. According to the sources, more than a thousand people in different parts of the East were engaged in the science of hadith until the middle of the 8th-11th centuries. About 14 thousand hadiths are woven from the names of our Prophet. Therefore, they have been repeatedly checked and restored to their current original state[10].

In the hadiths collected by these muhaddiths, the wisdom, instructions, recommended and prohibited rules of etiquette of Rasuli Akram are expressed. Hadiths reflect the sum of human intelligence, thinking, and philosophical thoughts as a source defining the criteria of human spiritual and moral perfection. The tolerance, modesty, modesty, justice, generosity, forgiveness, endurance of our Prophet Rasuli Akram are expressed in the hadiths narrated by the Blessed One .

The conclusion is that the hadiths are the Sunnah of the Prophet Muhammad (pbuh), which strengthen the confidence and faith of every person, and at the same time purify the human psyche and call for spiritual and moral perfection. Because Islam is based on enlightenment, it consists of belief and faith in bringing every person to perfection mentally, physically, spiritually and morally, serving only goodness, being noble, walking cleanly and not allowing ignorance, to protect one's brother, relatives, nation and is to preserve the material and spiritual values of the homeland and pass it on to the next generation.

Therefore, in the dangerous process of the globalization of the world and the movements in the modern information field, which are rapidly and deeply entering our life and lifestyle, Hadiths are an important source in the formation of a perfect person, and their use in the educational process, taking into account



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their pedagogical and psychological characteristics, is considered one of the urgent tasks of today.

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
