So, for young people, the book serves as a spiritual shield. One of such wonderful works is the scientific work "The image of Amir Temur" by the famous writer Pirimkul Kadyrov. The book is based on the fact that there were many fabrications and slanders against our great ancestor in different years. These fabrications are nothing more than an "information attack" on a historical figure. As you read the book "The Image of Amir Temur", you will be convinced that many historical facts have been established. For example, Ibn Arabshah's "Wonders of Destiny in the History of Timur", M. Brun's "I am Temurman who opened the world", "Tamerlane" published in Moscow in 1992, "Seven Climates Sultan" by the English writer Hilde Hukkem, A.Yu. Yakubovsky. This does not make any sense, - the author writes. It is not correct to give such a relation to an emir from the line of heroes. In Turkish, the word Taragay means "spread like light, multiply, occupy large areas." [4] Emphasizing that such wishes will come true, the writer mentions that Amir Temur first named his beloved grandson Ulugbek Taragay.

In the fight against the fabrications of great figures in some social networks today, we will achieve our goal only if we rely on such solid facts and evidence. At the same time, science-based books such as "The Image of Amir Temur" serve as a spiritual shield.

It has become a tradition for historians and poets to create many works about historical figures. At the same time, it is impossible to ignore the fact that they have been subjected to information attacks at different times. Muhammad Taragay Mirzo Ulugbek, one of the brightest figures of the Timurid dynasty, is uniquely glorified in historical works.
