The initiative includes 65 countries and the total cost is 21 trillion. is a dollar. According to the author, within the framework of the "One Place One Road" project, the countries of the Eurasian continent will unite economically and politically into a single system. Through the main components of the project: "Economic Belt of the Silk Road" ("Ekonomicheskiy poyas shyolkogo put") and "Sea Road in the 21st Century" ("Morskaya put v XXI veke"), logistics networks of all countries: railways, highways, air transport, energy pipelines and even connect to each other, more precisely, to China.

Within the framework of the program, it is planned to attract investments of more than 1 trillion US dollars in the development of the infrastructure of ports, highways, railways and airports, as well as power stations and telecommunications networks.

Currently, the countries of the world have different levels of resources and development and economic growth. One of the main reasons for this is the world order, which is mainly formed by the caritalist Western countries, mainly the USA. This world order, based on colonization and expansion, basically insists on abandoning this system that makes the rich richer and the poor poorer. This can partially explain the competition between the US and China for the new world order.

The main goal of the "One Place One Road" initiative is:

- Connecting countries with China by sea, land and air through all logistics networks;
 - Joint implementation of projects within the project;
 - Formation of political dialogue between all countries within the framework of the initiative;
 - Construction of large projects with the direct participation of China or its investment support;
- Consequences of the "One Place One Road" initiative:
- Increasing the integral dependence of all countries on China through a single transport system within the framework of the initiative;
 - Increasing economic dependence of countries on China through extensive investment;
 - The countries within the framework of the initiative will abandon the means of protecting the national economy, as well as the policy of protectionism, and as a result, the national markets will be filled with Chinese goods;
 - The origin of political dependence after economic dependence.

In modern Chinese foreign policy, today's world order is not based on equality and only serves the interests of economically developed countries, therefore, it is necessary to create a new system that is equal and fair for all, and this task should be carried out by China, which has a 5000-year-old civilization, and the



achievement of these goals is exactly this mega- it can be understood that it should be implemented through the project.

The principle of like-mindedness among countries is of great importance in the implementation of the "One Place One Road" initiative. He emphasized that common-mindedness in language is the main tool in "uniting the hearts of nations" and that it is necessary to promote the Chinese language through Chinese migrants and Confucian institutes, rather than promoting religion, unlike the West.
